Commission Regulation 11-10 Big Game Quotas 2011-2012

The Board held a discussion regarding the proposed quotas that are being proposed by the Nevada Department of Wildlife for the Pershing County area.

The Board discussed the Antelope population and quota recommendation with the representatives from NDOW.

Board member Scilacci moved to agree with the recommendation of the State for the proposed antelope quotas in Hunts 2151, 2161, 2251, 2171, 2181, and 2261. Board member Collins seconded.

The Board discussed the Elk population and quota recommendation with the representatives from NDOW.

Board member Scilacci moved to agree with the recommendation of the State for the proposed Elk quotas in Hunts 4102, 4151, 4156, 4161, 4181, 4176, 4111, 4251, 4256, and 4261. Board member Collins seconded.

The Board discussed the Desert Big Horn Sheep population and quota recommendation with the representatives from NDOW.

Board member Scilacci moved to agree with the recommendation of the State for the proposed Desert Big Horn Sheep quotas in Hunts 3151 and 3251. Board member Collins seconded.
