SB102 - Shed Antlers	Senate Natural Resources Committee –Requires the Board of Wildlife Commissioners to adopt regulations for the taking of shed antlers. (BDR 45-764)	Hearing possible on 3-9 in SNR
SB108 -Boat Fees	Senate Natural Resources Committee – Increases the fees for issuing certain numbers and validation decals for motorboats. (BDR 43-765)	Hearing possible on 3-9 in SNR
SB130 -OHV Registration extension	Legislative Committee on Public Lands (NRS 218E.510)- Revises provisions governing the titling and registration of off-highway vehicles. (S- 210)	
SCR1- Pine Forest Wilderness Wkng Group resolution	Legislative Committee on Public Lands - __CR: Expresses support for the Pine Forest Working Group and the Board of County Commissioners of Humboldt County in reexamining wilderness study areas located in the Pine Forest area of Humboldt County. (R-213)	
SJR4 -resolution on public lands	Urges Congress to take certain actions concerning federal public lands in Nevada. (BDR R-212)
