Dear Commissioner Lent:

This message is update the committee on the status of the Kelly Creek Heritage Project. I received the authorization to commence the project late in October of 2010. Shortly there after the wind blew my storage barn down and there was no place to store any of the supplies I would purchase for the project. There was no place to store any of the tools and equipment either since the building that was blown down is where I kept all of the tools and equipment for the property. I have spent the winter repairing the backhoe that broke while preparing the area to rebuild the storage barn. The weather has not been very conducive to working at the property. Because of the amount of moisture, if I could have gotten in to the property I would have ruined the road.

I have ordered and received the fencing and have spoken with the solar people. They sent me a quote, but I could not open it. I just received an email that my email somehow got in their junk mail, and they will be resending the quote. I expect it soon. As soon as I receive the refund from the fence I will order the solar for the water pumping. This week I plan to have the backhoe operational and will make arrangements to get it to the property.

With all that said I am requesting additional time (up to a year) to complete the project. I initially thought I could get it done last summer, but I could not. (I did not receive authorization until the end of October.) I still do not have a storage building, but the weather should be improving. Although it can be winter anytime in Eureka .

I do appreciate the opportunity you have given me to develop this water project for the wildlife in the area.

Because of the delay in getting the following projects approved by the Board of Examiners and because Wildlife Services was asked to complete the 2010 Heritage Projects first, the proponents request an extension for the following 2011 Heritage Projects.

1. Hunter's Alert, Inc. Project 11-26. A \$86,103 project to protect mule deer in western Nevada.
2. Nevada Alliance 4 Wildlife Project 11-19. A \$65,000 project to protect mule deer in eastern Nevada.
3. Nevada Alliance 4 Wildlife 11-20. A \$50,000 project to protect sage grouse in Nevada.

I have spoken with Pat Laughlin with Nevada Alliance 4 Wildlife and Cecil Fredi with Hunters Alert and was asked to request this extension on their behalf.
