

Trapping Regulation Frame Work:

Except as otherwise provided in this section, it is unlawful for a person to set a trap, other than a box or cage trap, within 1,000 feet of a residence within the borders of Clark County or Washoe County.

- 1. The provisions of this section do not apply to an employee of the Department acting in an official capacity.***
- 2. The provisions of this section do not apply to a person trapping under the authority of a permit issued by the Department.***
- 3. Nothing in this section is intended to prevent a person from controlling unprotected mice using a mouse trap in or about their residence.***
- 4. As used in this section:***
 - a. "Box or cage trap" means any device designed to contain or confine an animal within a box or cage. Any device designed, built or made to close upon any portion of an animal shall not be considered a box or cage trap.***
 - b. "Residence" means any house, room, apartment, tenement or other building designed and intended for occupancy as a residence.***
 - c. "Mouse trap" means a device whose structure and function indicates a device specifically designed for catching mice.***
 - d. "Unprotected mice" means all unprotected rodents in the family Muridae.***
