Particulars: Families are welcome to bring their children, have fun, and learn all about the wonderful birds in the Reno area. The group will be divided into 3 teams, and all bird species and numbers found at the wetland will be recorded. Following the count, we will meet back at the school parking lot to tally up our bird numbers. This data will then be entered into Cornell Lab of Ornithology's eBird data list. Bring your family and become scientists for the day and help birds!

Goodies: The first 40 participants will receive a goody bag and all participants will be provided with snacks and a warm beverage following the count.

What to Bring and Wear: Binoculars, spotting scope (if you have one), field guide, water, snacks, comfortable shoes, hat, sunscreen, etc. Always dress for the weather: this time of year can be cold so please wear warm coats, mittens, etc. The trail is paved and fairly flat. Binoculars are available and can be borrowed for the day.
