## **NDOW SPONSORS FLY FISHING FOR CARP CLINIC**

The Nevada Department of Wildlife is sponsoring a fly-fishing for carp clinic on Saturday, May 31, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. The clinic is designed for beginning and intermediate fly fishers and is free to all participants. The class is limited to the first 20 who sign-up. If you want to learn the most entertaining forms of fly-fishing try fly fishing for carp. Some say it's the bone fish of the desert. Pound for pound this fish will out fight nearly all fish in the fresh water world.

**WHAT** Class is geared for fly anglers. Mike Sevon, NDOW former regional supervisory fisheries biologist, will demonstrate techniques and equipment for fly fishing for the ever elusive carp.

**WHEN** Saturday, May 31 , 2008, starting at 8:00 a.m. and ending at noon

**WHERE** We will meet at the Nevada Department of Wildlife, **Fallon Office, 380 W. 'B' Street** and then proceed to the fishing location.

**AGES** Minimum 10 years of age.

**BRING** Participants are requested to provide their own tackle. Recommended rod is a 6-8 weight rod with a floating line. We also recommend bringing float tube, waders and some midge patterns size 12-14 and assorted wolly bugger patterns in sizes
