

**MASON VALLEY WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA  
CONTROLLED GOOSE HUNT  
2010-2011**

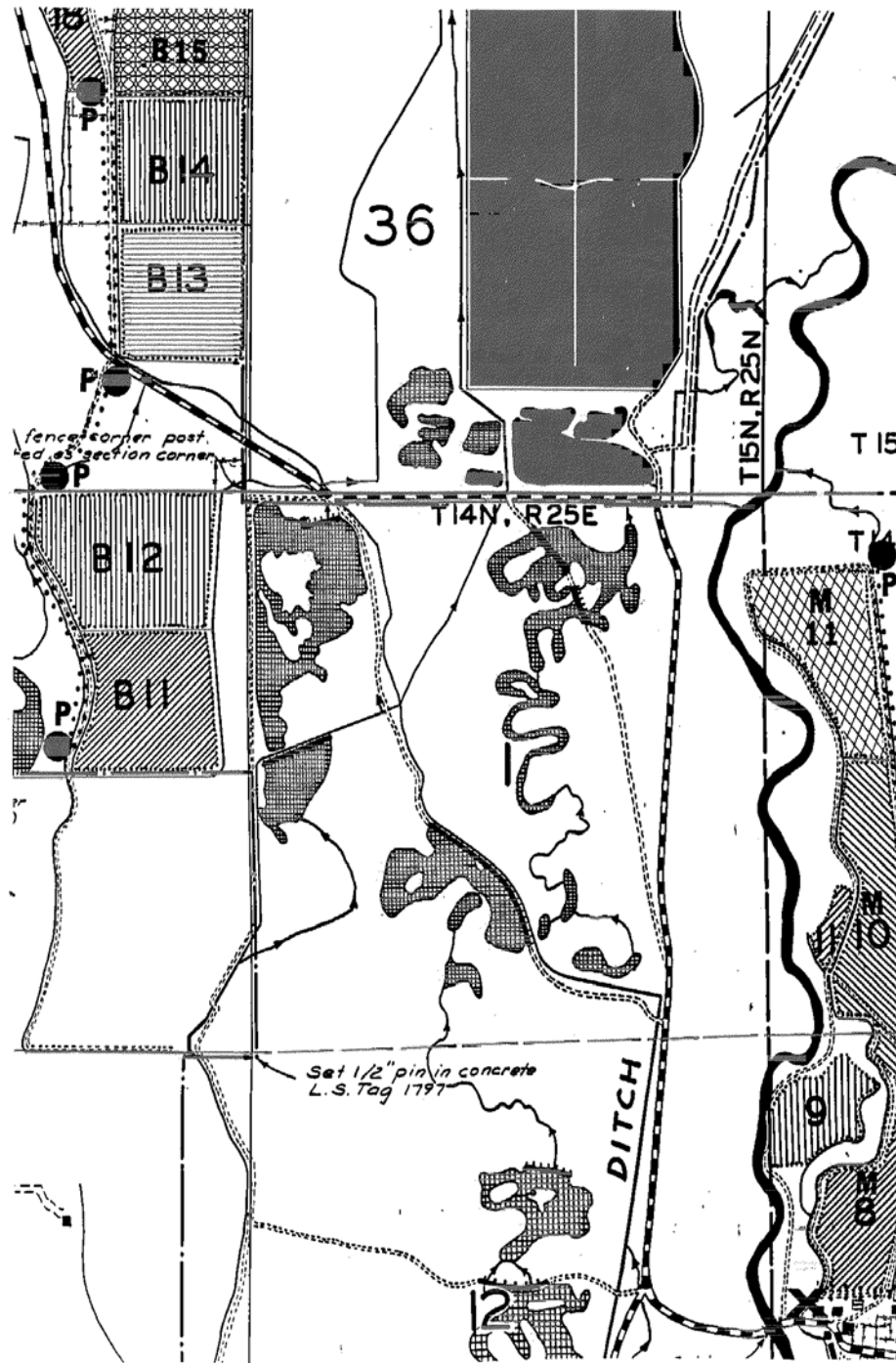
The Mason Valley Wildlife Management Area Controlled Goose Hunting Program is designed to provide a quality hunt by limiting the number of hunters to assigned blinds within the northwest portion of the MVWMA.

1. The Controlled Goose Hunt Zone is described as that portion of the Mason Valley Wildlife Management Area within Sections 1, 2 and 12, T14N, R25E, Section 35, T15N, R25E, Sections 6 and 7, T14N, R26E and Section 31, T15N, R26E, MDB&M as posted. The assigned blinds for the controlled goose hunt are located in farm fields MV-8, 10, and 11 and B-11, 12, 13, 14 and 15.
2. The hunt will be conducted on ten consecutive Saturdays beginning November 27, 2010 and ending on January 29, 2011. **Two of the Saturdays have been dedicated for family hunt opportunities – see information below hunter choice options.** In addition, two Wednesdays will be included in this year's hunt.
3. A total of eight blind locations (B11-B15 and MV8, MV10 and MV11) will be available, each of which will accommodate a maximum of four hunters. No more than 32 hunters will be allowed to hunt in the controlled goose hunt zone on any single day.
4. The Controlled Goose Hunt Zone is closed to all hunting except for waterfowl hunting by those people with a valid hunt reservation confirmation from the period of November 22, 2010 through January 29, 2011.
5. A hunter wishing to participate in the controlled goose hunt may submit and be listed on only **one** application per year for a daily hunt reservation confirmation. Hunters whose names appear **on more than one** application will be **rejected** from the drawing.
6. A maximum of **four** hunters may apply as a party on one application. Reservation confirmations are **not** transferable and all party members **must** hunt from the same assigned blind.\*
7. Applications for the 2010-2011 Mason Valley Wildlife Management Area Controlled Goose Hunt must be received by the Department of Wildlife, Headquarters Office, 1100 Valley Road, Reno NV 89512, through a postal service only, no later than **October 13, 2010**. Hunters may apply for up to five hunt dates in order of preference on their application. **ONLY COMPLETE AND LEGIBLE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR INCLUSION IN THE DRAWING.** A public drawing will be conducted at the Headquarters Office, at 10:00 a.m. on **October 27, 2010**. Successful applicants will receive a reservation confirmation by return mail.
8. A hunter with a reservation confirmation will be considered a "no show" if he does not present himself at the **Mason Valley Fish Hatchery Conference Room** by 5:15 a.m. on his assigned hunt day.
9. Blind assignments will be made using a lottery system at the time of check-in.
10. A special on-site lottery for unassigned blinds will be held for any "standby" hunters wishing to participate. The lottery will be held only if "standby" hunters are present by 5:30 a.m. and a blind vacancy exists.

**\*Substitution of hunter(s) will be allowed if one or more members of a successful party cannot hunt on the assigned day. However, it should be noted that at least one hunter from the original party must be present on the hunt day and no hunter is allowed to hunt more than once, under the authority of a reservation confirmation, during this year's hunt. Please note that the number of hunters listed on the original application will be the maximum number allowed per successful reservation confirmation.**
