



2010 HUNTING SEASON REMINDER

This hunting season, as you plan your outings and travel to and from hunting locations, please factor Ruby Pipeline Project construction and road and worker safety into your planning. You're likely to encounter numerous personnel, lots of construction activity, and increased road traffic in various areas along Ruby's 680-mile route, which extends from Wyoming to Oregon.

When traveling to and from your hunting locations by vehicle, drive friendly, share the road, be aware of general road safety and conditions in your areas, and exercise good safety precautions — *before and after hitting the road*.

Once at your locations, scout the area before beginning the hunt. Know your surroundings and make sure there are no construction personnel or work activities relating to pipeline construction within at least 1.5 miles of your location.

Once hunting, be sure of your target and what lies beyond. If there is pipeline construction nearby and/or pipeline workers, relocate to another area more than 1.5 miles from the nearest construction activity because high-velocity bullets can travel great distances, endanger personnel, and damage equipment.
