7. Additional application requirements:

(a) Insurance: An applicant for a license must provide proof that he carries liability insurance or a self-insured bond in the following amounts: (NOTE: Other agencies – BLM, USFS, NPS may require higher limits, so check first.)

- (1) At least \$100,000 for each person with a claim.
- (2) At least \$300,000 for each occurrence, and
- (3) At least \$25,000 for damage to property.

(b) An applicant for a guide's license must provide proof of current certification in a Red Cross Standard First Aid course or an equivalent approved by the Department with his original application for a license.

(c) Boating Safety Requirements: An applicant for a guide's license must provide proof of his United States Coast Guard License, if required for the body of water where the guiding will take place. If a boat will be used to provide a service to a client and a United States Coast Guard License is not required, the applicant must provide proof that he has successfully obtained a minimum score of 80 percent on the boating safety examination in the Navigating Nevada booklet, which may be obtained free of charge from the Nevada Department of Wildlife, 1100 Valley Road, Reno, Nevada 89512.

(d) Hunter Safety: Applicant must provide proof of completion of a course in the responsibilities of hunters approved by the Department.

(e) Credit Report Waiver: Sign and date authorization form for NDOW to obtain credit report from credit reporting agency.

REASON FOR DISAPPROVAL:

I. General Requirements -- applicable to all new applicants for a master guide license:

1. Must be a competent person of good moral character
2. Must be 21 years of age or older
3. Must pass appropriate written test (hunting, fishing, or hunting & fishing)
4. Must submit proof of current first aid with the application
5. If using a boat in the course of guiding activities, must submit proof with the application of his U.S. Coast Guard license (applies to navigable waters – L. Tahoe, Colorado River system) **or** proof he has passed the boating safety examination in **Boat Nevada**
6. If applying to guide hunters, submit proof of successful completion of a course in the responsibilities of hunters (i.e., hunter safety)
7. Submit authorization to obtain a credit report (treated confidential)
8. If the application is tentatively approved, the applicant will have to provide proof of insurance within 30 days of application approval.

II. Experience Criteria & Submission Requirements (the following experience criteria requirements are not applicable to and are not required of applicants who are applying only to provide guide services limited to fishing.)

Experience Criteria #1. The applicant must submit:

1. Proof that the applicant possessed a valid subguide license or held an equivalent position in another state, Canadian province or foreign country for at least **2** of the 5 years immediately preceding the date of application; **and**
2. Proof that the applicant successfully completed a licensed training program for hunting guides within 5 years immediately preceding the date of application; and
3. Four (4) letters of recommendation written by clients whom the applicant personally guided during the period described in #1 above; **and**
4. **Either** a letter of recommendation written by the master guide, registered guide, professional guide or outfitter who employed the applicant as a subguide, or an equivalent position, during the period described in #1 above, **OR** submit proof that he spent a minimum of 15* days guiding clients in the field during the period described in #1 above.

Experience Criteria #2. The applicant must submit:

1. Proof that the applicant possessed a valid subguide license or held an equivalent position in another state, Canadian province or foreign country for at least **3** of the 5 years immediately preceding the date of application; **and**
2. Four (4) letters of recommendation written by clients whom the applicant personally guided during the period described in #1 above; **and**
3. **Either** a letter of recommendation written by the master guide, registered guide, professional guide or outfitter who employed the applicant as a subguide, or an equivalent position, during the period described in #1 above, **OR** submit proof that he spent a minimum of 15* days guiding clients in the field during the period described in #1 above.

Experience Criteria #3. The applicant must submit:

1. Proof that he held the position of, or was licensed in another state, Canadian province or foreign country as a master guide, registered guide, professional guide or outfitter and has at least 20 days of guiding experience for at least 2 of the 5 years immediately preceding the date of application.
