To: Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners

Re: Item #1 on Agenda for Aug 14, 2009. Election of Officers.

We, as a Game Board who represent the Sportsmen and Sportswomen of the state of Nevada, discussed the Wildlife Commission and the input we have received about them over the last year. We were in agreement that their Chairman has created more hate and discontent within the Department and the Sportsmen and Sportswomen of the State of Nevada than we have ever seen. It is a shame that we as Board members are ashamed of the way things have been done and the way people have been treated.

We feel that now is the time to change the Commission leaders and get us all working for the betterment of wildlife and working on the concerns of sportsmen and women of the state. We know there are qualified men on the commission that are capable of leading and conducting themselves in a civil manner so as to not embarrass all associated with the commission and the Dept. We know with wildlife being what it is that we will never be at 100% agreement, but we need to be able to work in a civil manner to achieve what is expected of us all.

We realize that to ask for change with no suggestions may not be the best thing to do. With most of the commissioners being fairly new we realize that we don't know a lot about any one of them. We have observed that Mr. McBeath has demonstrated an ability to listen and to talk without alienating everyone around him. What we have seen leads us to recommend him as a candidate for Chairman. Mr. Wallace is very quiet but in my personal discussions with him he has shown an interest in the wildlife and does not seem to be the type of person to let his personal feelings get in the way of getting things done for the good of the people of Nevada.
