Call to Order – Kevin Strozzi-Chairman

Approval of Minutes-Action

MOTION: John Terras made the motion to approve the minutes of January 30, 2010 meeting.

1. County Board to Manage Wildlife Member Items - Informational:

John asked if the State had planted any fish. They planted various places. Kingston was one of the places planted. They are planning on fixing the dam in Kingston.

2. Commission General Regulation Number 383, LCB File No. R005-10-Wildlife Hwy Crossing - Action

There are not any Wildlife Hwy Crossings in the area for this board.

3. Commission Regulation 389, LCB file No. R083-10 - Action

Tom Donham explained that this regulation meant that this means turning off or interfering with the use of a guzzler forcing animals to water in a different spot.

4. Commission Regulation 07-07 Amendment #6 – Upland Game and Furbearer Seasons and Bag Limits – Action

Charlie asked if the counts for Sage Grouse are up or down or stable. Tom said that the counts are stable, maybe increased a little bit. It seems that since the season has changed to rifle season it has affected the hunt, but Tom said that a study was done and that this isn't really making a dent on the count. The wing barrels are important for collecting data.

MOTION: Charlie Cecchini made a motion to approve Sage Grouse Season; no recommendation on the Wild Turkey Seasons; to approve that the Grey Fox season to run concurrent with Bobcat season December 1st through February 20th; to approve the Pelt Sealing dates in Tonopah.

5. Request for Recommendations from the Mule Deer Restoration Committee - Action

The board discussed recommendations to the Mule Deer Restoration Committee on how to restore the states Mule Deer Population.
