THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 502.253 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 502.253 1. In addition to any fee charged and collected pursuant to
3 NRS 502.250, a fee of \$3 must be charged for processing each application
4 for a game tag, the revenue from which must be accounted for separately,
5 deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the Wildlife Account in the
6 State General Fund and used by the Department ~~for~~ for costs related to:
7 (a) Programs ~~projects~~ for the management and control of injurious
8 predatory wildlife;
9 (b) Wildlife management activities relating to the protection of
10 nonpredatory game animals, sensitive wildlife species and related wildlife
11 habitat;
12 (c) Conducting research, as needed, to determine successful techniques
13 for managing and controlling predatory wildlife, including studies
14 necessary to ensure effective programs for the management and control of
15 injurious predatory wildlife; and

1 (d) Programs for the education of the general public concerning the
2 management and control of predatory wildlife, ~~for the enhancement of~~
3 ~~mule deer populations.~~

4 2. The Department of Wildlife is hereby authorized to expend a
5 portion of the money collected pursuant to subsection 1 to enable the State
6 Department of Agriculture to develop and carry out the programs
7 ~~projects~~ described in subsection 1.

8 3. Any ~~project~~ program developed or wildlife management activity
9 or research conducted pursuant to this section must be approved by the
10 Commission.

11 4. The money in the Wildlife Account remains in the Account and
12 does not revert to the State General Fund at the end of any fiscal year.

13 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
