So I only have just the ONE complaint. The loss of the Non-resident Elk - Antlered Any Legal Weapon Hunt 4251 specifically for area 161-164 **EARLY** season. To have taken away the Non-resident Early season in 2009 and 2010 and then to add insult to injury to RAISE the Resident tags for that Same unit and early season hunt from 5 to in 2010 going up to **12** really does NOT seem fair to those of us that have been applying for that early season all these years! I have been at a loss to explain it now to my friends and family that I have been bragging to these last few years on how Great and Fair Nevada is to it's hunters - Resident AND Non-resident alike! The last 2 years without our favorite Early season in area 161-164 they have all been just taking the 'Bonus Points Only' option.

Please - renew my faith in Nevada's fair game management and return the Non-Resident **Early Elk** season for area **161-164**.
