


**2012 and 2013 Bear Hunt**  
 Sept. 15 to Dec. 31 each year


After receiving public input from hunters and non-hunters alike, changes to the 2012 bear hunt were recommended by NDOW and adopted by the Board of Wildlife Commissioners.

Hunters indicated that the August 20 beginning to the season was too early with summer conditions difficult on the bears, the hunters and the hunter's dogs. Non-hunters worried about conflicts between hunters and other public land user groups during the busy summer tourist season.

The changes recommended and adopted by the Wildlife Commission included the closure of the Lake Tahoe Basin and some selected trail areas on Mount Rose to bear hunting. September 15 was chosen as the date to begin the hunt, eliminating over three weeks from the length of the season.
