Call To Order, Pledge of Allegiance, Introduction of Committee Members and Roll Call:

Committee Chairman East called the meeting to order at 8:01am. Management Analyst Kailey Taylor called role.

Approval of Agenda:

Committee Chairman East asked if the Committee had any changes to the agenda. There were none.

COMMISSIONER JOHNSTON MOVED TO APPROVE THE AGENDA. COMMISSIONER VALENTINE SECONDED THE MOTION. THE MOTION CARRIED 3-0.

Approval of Minutes:

Committee Chairman East asked if the Committee had any changes to the minutes. There were none.

COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN EAST MOVED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES. COMMISSIONER JOHNSTON SECONDED THE MOTION. THE MOTION CARRIED 3-0.

Review of Bill/Bill Draft Request (BDR) Tracking List:

Committee Chairman East mentioned that the deadline for the Committee Passage (1st house) has passed and that the First House Passage deadline is March 23rd. She noted the following changes: AB74 is dead, SB55 received a Do Pass, AB83 received an Amend and Do Pass and explained some of the changes regarding that bill, SB85 received an Amend and Do Pass, SB17 received a Do Pass, AB30 received an Amend and Do Pass, AB51 is dead, AB62 received an Amend and Do Pass, AB70 passed out of Committee but does not affect us, AB84 has an exemption and is in the Assembly Committee on Ways and Means, AB113 received a Do Pass and is already in the Senate, AB153 received a Do Pass, AB163 received an Amend and Do Pass, AB167 is dead, AB233 received an Amend and Do Pass, AB265 received an Amend and Do Pass, AB404 received an Amend and Do Pass and will most likely incorporate parts of AB474 regarding tag transfers, AB473 was not

considered, however we should not consider it dead, AB474 received an Amend and Do Pass, AB479 received an Amend and Do Pass, SB120 has an exemption, SB140 received a Do Pass, SB261 is dead, SB275 received a Do Pass, SB280 is dead, SB316 received an Amend and Do Pass, SB433 received an Amend and Do Pass, SB439 is dead, SB454 received a Do Pass, SB487 did not have a hearing, ACR4 received a Do Pass, AJR2 received an Amend and Do Pass, AJR7 received a Do Pass, AJR8 received a Do Pass, SJR3 received an Amend and Do Pass, SJR4 received a Do Pass, SJR3 received a Do Pass, AJR3 received a Do Pass, and SB96 received a Do Pass.

Public Comment –

Karen Boeger, Backcountry Hunters and Anglers asked a question regarding AB404 and the possibility incorporating portions of AB474.

Committee Chairman East explained that she believes the portion of AB747 regarding the spending down of Heritage Funds will most likely be moved into AB83, but some of the tag transfer portion of that bill may not make it. The language in AB404 currently excludes organizations.

Committee Chairman East noted that the next few weeks may be hectic with the First House Passage Deadline.

Committee Review of Legislation, Recommendations on Commission Positions on Legislation and Legislative Platforms:

Committee Chairman East said she does not have any additional bills that the Committee needs to take a position on.

Commissioner Johnston did not have any recommendations. He believes the Committee has taken a position on everything already.

Commissioner Valentine said he agreed with Commissioner Johnston.

Future Committee Meetings:

Committee Chairman East said she does not think the Committee needs to meet before the Commission Meeting. If something comes up, another meeting can be scheduled.

Management Analyst Taylor said the Committee is scheduled to meet Friday morning before the Commission Meeting.
