SHOULD YOU WISH TO SPEAK ON AN AGENDA ITEM OR COMMENT ON ANY OTHER MATTER DURING THE PUBLIC COMMENT SECTION OF THE AGENDA, WE RESPECTFULLY REQUEST THAT YOU OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING: (1) PLEASE COMPLETE PUBLIC COMMENT - INTEREST CARD. (2) PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME AND HOME ADDRESS FOR THE RECORD. (3) IN FAIRNESS TO OTHERS, GROUPS OR ORGANIZATIONS ARE REQUESTED TO DESIGNATE ONE SPOKESPERSON. (4) IN THE INTEREST OF TIME, YOU ARE ENCOURAGED TO GIVE BRIEF, NON-REPETITIVE STATEMENTS TO ENSURE THAT ALL RELEVANT INFORMATION IS PRESENTED TO AID THE BOARD IN REACHING A DECISION. ACCORDING TO NRS 203.090, ANY PERSON WHO WILLFULLY DISTURBS ANY MEETING, SHALL BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR. NRS 241.030 PROVIDES FOR THE REMOVAL OF ANY PERSON WHO WILLFULLY DISRUPTS A MEETING TO THE EXTENT THAT ITS ORDERLY CONDUCT IS MADE IMPRACTICAL.

Citizens Code of Conduct

The Clark County Advisory Board to Manage Wildlife has been entrusted with the responsibility of conducting legitimate business in its capacity as an advisory board to the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners on behalf of all residents of the County of Clark. The Clark County Advisory Board to Manage Wildlife encourages citizens to participate in public hearings and to provide relevant testimony to aid in the performance of its advisory duties. In order to assure that such business is conducted in an efficient and effective manner, citizens providing testimony to the Board must adhere to the following rules of conduct:

- When speaking on a specific agenda item, keep comments relevant to the item.
- Keep all comments relevant to the purview of the Clark County Advisory Board to Manage Wildlife. The Board’s duties are: solicit and evaluate local opinion and advise the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners on matters relating to the management of wildlife within the County of Clark.
- Do not use the meeting as a forum to utter personal, impertinent, accusatory, slanderous or profane remarks.
- Do not disrupt, disturb, or otherwise impede the conduct of the meeting.
- Keep comments as concise and to the point as possible.

According to NRS 203.090, any person who willfully disturbs any meeting shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. NRS 241.030 provides for the removal of any person who willfully disrupts a meeting to the extent that its orderly conduct is made impractical.
