Item 7(A) – Commission General Regulation 477, Landowner Deer and Antelope Compensation Tag Program, LCB File No. 096-18.

Member Curran said, starting about a year ago, we discussed this when they were first having the problem of being over-allocated from what the statute allowed. I think we have reviewed this several times. I looked at it again myself and I think, with the landowners and other sportsman organizations agreeing, I would have no other suggestions for any amendments to this. I think this is probably the best workable solution that they could come up with.

Member Curran made a motion to approve the recommendation of the Department of Wildlife for Commission General Regulation 477, Landowner Deer and Antelope Compensation Tag Program. Member Sibley seconded the motion, which carried by unanimous vote.

7(B) – Commission General Regulation 478, Bighorn Sheep Ewe and Mountain Goat Online Course, LCB File No. R151-18.

Member Gubler said I guess I wouldn't be opposed to this. Member Curran said the way that I read this is that there are two parts. One of those is to require an online course to identify what a ewe sheep looks like so they aren't taking young rams and the same with the mountain goat where they are taking so many females. The second part is that it actually makes it easier for the hunter as every one of these species has to be brought in for verification. The way I read it is that it would eliminate the need to then also do a harvest questionnaire in addition to the one you do when you get your lion seal or sheep seal. Mr. Gubler agreed but said I don't know why a mountain lion isn't an either/or. It is the same as a mountain goat. I don't understand why you would have to take a class for a lion. Member Sibley said it says the tag holder for ram bighorn sheep, mountain goat, mountain lion, or bear to provide the questionnaire information. You have to check a lion in anyway, so you will do your questionnaire right then and it is not an online course. Member Gubler said I understand now and that answers my question.

Member Gubler made a motion to support Commission General Regulation 478, Bighorn Sheep Ewe and Mountain Goat Online Course. Member Sibley seconded the motion, which carried by unanimous vote.

7(C) – Commission General Regulation 479, Rosy Boa Reptile, LCB File No. 152-18.

Member Curran made a motion to accept the recommendation for the scientific name change of the Rosy Boa from *Lichanura trivirgata* to *Lichanura orcutti*. Member Sibley seconded the motion, which carried by unanimous vote.

8. Commission Regulation 18 - 12 Amendment #1 2018-2018 Upland Game and Furbearer Seasons and Bag Limits.

Member Sibley made a motion to accept the changes as indicated. Member Gubler seconded the motion, which carried by unanimous vote.




