9A: Commission General Regulation 493, NAC Simplification

The board was in agreeance of having no comment on the regulation, but supports moving forward with the initiative.

10A: Commission General Regulation 490, Party Bonus Points and First Come First Serve, LCB File NO. 103-19

The board has previously commented on Regulation 490. The board was in agreeance of having no new comments, but stated they maintain their previous position moving forward.

10B: Commission General Regulation 491, Notification of Draw Results, LCB File No. R058-20

The board had previously reviewed and commented on this initiative. The board is in agreeance on supporting moving forward with the current initiative.

10C: Commission General Regulation 492, Thermal Optics LCV File No. R035-20

12: Mule Deer Enhancement Program

The board and Mr. Garrett discussed what the Mule Deer Enhancement Program would entail. The program would create Mule Deer Teams based on hunt units. The teams would then develop/prioritize project proposals to address limiting factors in their areas.
