Fisheries outlook in the county are bleak.

Ryepatch –Some die offs not huge numbers but fishing is still good.

Knott Creek- Big die off. Lots of algae.

Onion Res. - Drying up.

Blue Lakes- Water level still decent, fishing good.

Bilk-Water down some. Catching bass not trout.

Chimney- Water level o.k.. Cathing small walleye.

Wiilow- Drying up.

Spaulding- Drying up.

### **Review of Commission Agenda-**

Discussion on road kill removal for sage Hen. Program. Many board members feel we are wasting money on this program.

Discussion on trail cameras. Differing views on how and when cameras should be used.

\*-Motion to allow trail camera use prior to hunting seasons for scouting purposes. Would like the language to mirror the use of aircraft regulation.

Motion passed 4-0.

Some other issues were noted as potential problems in the future.

1. Camera registration.
2. Do not like remote down loading/ satellite technology.
3. Non-hunters using camera and relaying info to hunters etc.

\*-Motion to support the Dept. recommendations for all migratory regulations.

Discussion on trapping regulation (Item #20).

\*- Motion to strike language that reads the tag has to be attached within 6 inches of trapping device. This requirement would allow the trapped animal to destroy the tag. Recommend allowing the tag to be attached away from the trapping device near the chain anchor or on the trapping device itself.
