Review of Commission's Agenda:

Discussion on carrying a sidearm while archery hunting. Larry Allen would like to see no restriction to type, caliber of handgun during archery season.

Motion to accept the Dept. recommendations concerning allowing archers to carry a handgun while hunting.

Motion to support the Dept. recommendations regarding the shed horn season and private land owners.

The HCAB would like to stress again to the Commission our desire to have the shed hunting season start Feb. 1, this will coincide with the upland game season and allow upland hunters to harvest shed horns while they are upland hunting. Even if this is granted to only to the counties where upland hunting is predominate, such as Humboldt. We understand the logic behind the season and the desire to protect the elk and deer herds from harassment by shed hunters, but we also are under the impression that most of the trouble has historically been with the elk herds in counties like White Pine and Elko. We believe other counties are the victim of unneeded

restriction due to this season that has blanketed the whole state, whether it was needed or not.
