1. Call to order
  - Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.
  - Members Present: Jessie Weller, Rob Jacobson, Walt Mandeville, Wes Clyde, Joe Crawford
  - Guests Present: Susan Crawford
  
2. Pledge of Allegiance
  - No action taken.
  
3. For Possible Action: Approval of minutes
  - Jessie moved to approve the minutes of September 17, 2018; Walt offered a second. The vote was called for and passed; 5-0 unanimous.
  
4. Public participation: It is anticipated that public participation will be held at this time, though it may be returned to at any time during the agenda. The Board will conduct public comment after discussion of each agenda action item, but before the Board takes any action.

6. Advisory Board Items for discussion (No action will be taken)
  - Walt brought up off road vehicles interfering with peoples hunts. Him and his son witnessed people going cross country? Who can enforce off-road travel, is it BLM, Game Wardens, Division of Forestry? **Walt requested that this be place on the agenda for the next meeting for further discussion... and possible action.**
  - Joe bought up the issue of hunter harassment on Face book. One comment posted read "When do we get to start hunting bear hunters." -Rob mentioned different budget items (Vortex Optics) and the possibility of trading ad-space in the regulations for these types of purchases. Wes mentioned that this practice may be illegal. Jessie mentioned that he would like to be informed of which division of the Dept. these purchases would be going, among others.

-Rob made a motion that the transplant list of bighorn sheep would include not only where the sheep are being transplanted to but where they are being removed from. Wes seconded Robs Motion. Passed 5-0

8. For Possible Action: Request update from Nevada Department of Wildlife on the result of the shed antler regulation.

-Jessie mentioned that a picture of a game warden caught on trail camera carrying a brown elk antler was floating around social media. He mentioned that the effectiveness of the regulation only impacted law abiding citizens. He stated that this was the first year that this regulation was in place and there have been discrepancies of the dates, enforcement among other issues. He stated that with this being the first year that it should be reviewed and re-evaluated. **Jessie made a motion that, "The Dept of Wildlife gives a review to the public concerning the number of tickets issued, # of antlers confiscated, amount in fines..and based on the information gathered does the law and or dates need to be re-evaluated.** Wes seconded the motion. Passed 5-0.

9. For Possible Action: Discussion and possible action for the Vice Chairman vacancy.
