**Resident Mule Deer Antlered: Hunt 1331 ALW
Unit 041-042 - We would like the tags reduced from 25 to 15 – These deer are not surveyed and the population estimate is low. Hunter success was at 34%. We feel that hunter opportunity is adequate at 15 tags**

Unit 043-046 – We would like to see the tags reduced from 90 to 50 in the early and from 40 to 20 in the late season. We feel that declining population and poor recruitment necessitate an approach to try and save some of the population for the future.

**Resident Mule Deer Antlered: Hunt 1331 Muzzleloader
041-042 - We would like to see the tags reduced from 10 to 5 for reasons mentioned and to follow in line with the ALW reduction**

043-046 - We would like to see the tags reduced from 20 to 10 for reasons mentioned and to follow in line with the ALW reduction

**Resident Mule Deer Antlered: Hunt 1331 Archery
041-042 - We would like to see the tags reduced from 15 to 10 for reasons mentioned and to follow in line with the ALW reduction**

043-046 - We would like to see the tags reduced from 60 to 35 for reasons mentioned and to follow in line with the ALW reduction

**Nonresident Mule Deer Antlered: Hunt 1331 ALW
041-042 - We would like to see the tags reduced from 3 to 2 for reasons mentioned and to follow in line with the Resident ALW reduction**

043-046 - We would like to see the tags reduced from 6 to 5 in the early season and from 3 to 2 in the late season for reasons mentioned and to follow in line with the Resident ALW reduction
