**NOTICE OF HEARING FOR ADOPTION OF COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

The Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners will hold a public hearing at 8:30 am, on February 11, 2017 at the Nevada State Capitol Building, Capitol Assembly Chambers, Second Floor, 101 N. Carson Street, Carson City, Nevada 89701 and videoconferenced to the Grant Sawyer Building, 555 E. Washington Ave., Fifth Floor, Ste. 5100, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption of commission regulations. If a person who is directly affected by the proposed action fails to appear to request to make an oral presentation, the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

**Commission Regulation 17 - 03, 2017 Black Bear Seasons**

The Commission will consider adopting 2017 hunting season dates, open management units, hunting hours, special regulations, animal sex, legal weapon requirements, hunt boundary restrictions, and dates and times for indoctrination courses for black bear.

**Commission Regulation 17 - 04, 2017 - 2018 Mountain Lion Season and Harvest Limits**

The Commission will consider adopting 2017 - 2018 mountain lion hunting season open units, harvest limits by unit group, hunting hours, and special regulations.

**Commission Regulation 17 - 05, 2017 - 2018 and 2018 - 2019 Big Game Seasons**

The Commission will consider adopting 2017 - 2018 and 2018 - 2019 hunting seasons and dates for mule deer, pronghorn antelope, elk, bighorn sheep, and mountain goat, including limits, hunting hours, special hunt eligibility, animal sex, physical characteristics and legal weapon requirements, hunt boundary restrictions, and legal weapon requirements, and emergency depredation hunt structure and statewide quotas.

**Commission Regulation 17 - 06, 2018 Heritage Tag Seasons and Quotas**

The Commission will consider the adoption of the 2018 Heritage Tag hunt species, seasons and quotas.

**Commission Regulation 17- 07, 2017 Dream Tag Seasons**

The Commission will consider the adoption of the 2017 Dream Tag seasons.

**Commission Regulation 17- 08, 2017 Partnership in Wildlife Seasons and Quotas**

The Commission will consider the adoption of the 2017 PIW hunt species, seasons and quotas.

**Commission Regulation 17 - 09, 2017 Silver State Tag Seasons and Quotas**

The Commission will consider the adoption of the 2017 Silver State Tag hunt species, seasons and quotas.

**Commission Regulation 17 - 10, 2017 Big Game Application Deadline Information**

The Commission will consider adopting language regarding the 2017 big game tag application deadline information.

**Commission Regulation 17 - 11, 2017 Big Game Tag Application**

The Commission will consider adopting language regarding the 2017 big game tag application eligibility, to include ability to apply for bull and spike elk, and ram and ewe of same bighorn subspecies.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Secretary of the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners, 6980 Sierra Center Parkway, Suite 120, Reno, Nevada 89511. Written submissions must be received at least five days before the scheduled public hearing.

A copy of the regulations to be adopted will be on file at the State Library, 100 N. Stewart Street, Carson City, Nevada and at each Nevada county library in which an office of the agency is not maintained, for inspection by members of the public during business hours. Additional copies of the regulations to be adopted will be available at the Nevada Department of Wildlife, 6980 Sierra Center Parkway, Suite 120, Reno, Nevada, 89511 for inspection and copying by members of the public during business hours. Copies will be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies if it is deemed necessary.

## CR 17-03 2017 BLACK BEAR SEASON

The Board of Wildlife Commissioners under the authority of Section 501.181, 503.090, 503.140 and 503.245 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, does hereby adopt the following regulations for the management of black bear

### Resident and Nonresident Black Bear - Either Sex Any Legal Weapon Hunt 6151 and 6251

Unit Group	2017 Season
Hunt units 192*, 194*, 195, 196 are open to bear hunting except those portions of 192 and 194 described below in Special Regulations.	Sept 15 - Dec 1 (or until harvest limits are met)
Hunt units 201, 202, 204 and 206 are open to bear hunting	Sept 15 - Dec 1 (or until harvest limits are met)
Hunt unit 291 is open to bear hunting	Sept 15 - Dec 1 (or until harvest limits are met)

- The limit is one animal per tag.
- Hunting hours are one-half hour before sunrise to sunset.
- Tag holders, or their licensed guide if applicable, must call the Black Bear Harvest Information Hotline prior to hunting to determine if the hunt has been closed due to the harvest objective being reached. The number is 1-800-800-1667 and is accessible 24 hours a day.
- Black Bear indoctrination classes will be held on Saturday, August 12, 2017 and on Saturday, September 9, 2017. Both classes will be held from 1 pm to 4pm at the Nevada Department of Wildlife's conference room, 1100 Valley Road, Reno, Nevada. Attendance at one black bear indoctrination class is mandatory for tag holders or their representative guides or sub-guides. A person represented by a guide or sub-guide at the indoctrination may only hunt under the direct supervision of the guide or sub-guide who attended the class for them. Tags will only be issued upon completion of an indoctrination class.
- The Department phone number to call and report a harvested black bear is 775-688-BEAR. Leave a message. A secondary number is 775-720-6130.

**\*Special Regulations**

Those areas within Units 194 and 192 that are within the U.S. Forest Service Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit (LTBMU) and those areas bounded on the west by the LTBMU boundary from the southern boundary of Township 16 North, Range 18 East, Section 13 to the Mount Rose Wilderness Area boundary (approximately located at the Relay Ridge Radio Tower), by the Mount Rose Wilderness Area boundary from the LTBMU boundary to the western boundary of Range 19 East, and by the western boundary of Range 19 East from the Mount Rose Wilderness Area boundary to USFS Road No. 41049 (Logan Meadow Lane/Thomas Creek), bounded on the north by USFS Road No. 41049 from the western boundary of Range 19 East to Timberline Drive, by Timberline Drive from its junction with USFS Road No. 41049 to State Highway 431 (Mount Rose Highway), and by State Highway 431 from its junction with Timberline Drive to its junction with U.S. Highway 395, bounded on the east by U.S. Highway 395 from its junction with State Highway 431 to the southern boundary of Township 16 North, Range 19 East, Section 14 (approximately located at the northbound Bellevue Interchange off-ramp), and bounded on the south by the southern edge of Township 16 North, Range 19 East, Sections 14 – 18, following the southern boundary of the University of Nevada, Reno Little Valley Study Area, and Township 16 North, Range 18 East, Section 13 to the LTBMU boundary.

**\*Special Regulations**

- Unit 091 is an Interstate hunt with Utah. Nevada and Utah hunters may hunt within open units in both states (Nevada Unit 091, Utah Unit 1C). Nevada hunters hunting in Utah must abide by Utah regulations and season dates on the Utah portion of the hunt area.

**2017 and 2018 BIG GAME SEASONS**

The Board of Wildlife Commissioners under the authority of sections 501.181, 502.140, 503.120 and 503.140 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, does hereby adopt the following regulation for the big game resource.

Note: The limit is one animal per tag and the hunting hours are one-half hour before sunrise to sunset for all big game hunts, unless otherwise specified.

The Organization shall submit the full amount of the bid as well as the name of the designated hunter to the Department of Wildlife no later than 30 days after the auction is held. Should a sealed bid process become necessary, sealed bids will be accepted by the Department of Wildlife, 6980 Sierra Center Pkwy, Ste. 120, Reno, Nevada 89511, on or before 5:00 p.m., on the third Friday following the deadline established in subsection 2. In the event of an identical sealed bid, the tag will be awarded based on the bid having the earliest postmark or date stamp.

The successful bidder of the sealed bid shall submit the full amount of his bid within 10 calendar days after notification by the Department. Failure to comply with this provision shall result in the tag being awarded to the next highest bidder.

4. The successful bidder for each tag type may hunt statewide in units where a season is established by Commission for that species except those areas closed to hunting in NAC 504.340 and identified in this regulation.

## CR 17-09 SILVER STATE HUNTS

The Board of Wildlife Commissioners under the authority of sections 501.181, 502.140, 502.250, 503.140 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, does hereby adopt the following regulation for the management of the wildlife resource. NRS 502.250 authorizes the Wildlife Commission to designate the number Wildlife Heritage game tags and Silver State tags to allocate each year.

**Hunting Hours:** One-half hour before sunrise to sunset, the same to be considered according to Government sunrise-sunset tables.

**Limit:** One animal per tag.

**Legal Weapon:** Any legal weapon may be used throughout the season.

\* Fallon NAS - There are portions of unit 181 in Naval Air Station (NAS) Fallon where public access is restricted. To hunt Nelson (desert) bighorn sheep in the NAS portions of this unit, the tag holder is required to attend a NAS hunter safety briefing.

\*Portions of Hunt units 252, 280, 281, 282 are within the Nevada Test and Training Range (NTTR) where public access is **restricted**. Hunters and everyone in their respective hunting parties, must comply with all Nevada hunting requirements and all NTTR safety and security requirements including the following: 1) consent to and pass a criminal history background check, 2) be at least 14 years old on opening day of the respective hunting season, 3) attend the Nellis Air Force Base hunter safety briefing, and 4) within the NTTR portion of unit 252 limit party size to 5 including tag holder. Additional party members may complete background check and safety briefing, but only maximum of 5 party members including tag holder may be present within the NTTR portion of unit 252 at any given time.

\*Hunters and members of their parties who fail to comply with these requirements may be denied access to the NTTR. Hunters and members of their parties may not access the NTTR after a tag is filled and animal has been removed and in possession of tag holder. No pets are allowed on NTTR. It is the hunter's responsibility to meet and/or comply with all NTTR eligibility requirements. In some units there may be adjustments to season dates to accommodate Department of Defense operations. **Silver State Tag Application Eligibility**

A person may submit an application for a species in the Silver State tag draw and if eligible submit an application for the same species or subspecies in the big game tag draw.

**Antelope Application Eligibility**

An eligible person may apply for **ONE** type of hunt category for **antelope** in a draw application period.

Except as otherwise provided in regulation a person **MAY NOT OBTAIN** more than **ONE** antelope tag during a hunting season.

**Elk Application Eligibility**

An eligible person **MAY APPLY ONCE** for **ONE** type of hunt category of **antlered elk or antlered elk depredation** in a draw application period.

~~OR~~ **AND**

An eligible person **MAY APPLY ONCE** for **ONE** type of hunt category of **spike elk** in a draw application period.

**AND**

An eligible person **MAY APPLY ONCE** for each type of hunt category of **antlerless elk, antlerless elk management tag and antlerless elk depredation** in a draw application period.

Except as otherwise provided in regulation a person **MAY OBTAIN** one antlered elk tag **OR** one spike elk tag **AND** one antlerless elk tag during a hunting season.

**Bighorn Sheep Application Eligibility**

An eligible person **MAY APPLY** for a type of hunt category for any subspecies of **ram bighorn sheep** in a draw application period.

~~OR~~ **AND**

An eligible person **MAY APPLY** for a type of hunt category for any subspecies of **ewe bighorn sheep** in a draw application period.

**Except as otherwise provided in regulation a person MAY OBTAIN only one bighorn sheep tag for a subspecies.**

**Mountain Goat Application Eligibility**

An eligible person **MAY APPLY** for a type of hunt category for a **mountain goat** in a draw application period.

**Black Bear Application Eligibility**

An eligible person **MAY APPLY** for a type of hunt category for a **black bear** in a draw application period.

**Mule Deer Application Eligibility**

An eligible person **MAY APPLY** for **ONE** type of hunt category for **mule deer** in a draw application period.

Except as otherwise provided in this regulation a person **MAY NOT OBTAIN** more than **ONE** deer tag during a hunting season.

A person may obtain an Antlerless Depredation deer hunt 1101 tag in addition to 1107, 1331, 1341, 1371, 1181 tag if the application for the Antlerless Depredation deer hunt 1101 is submitted in a separate draw application period.

**Other Tags and Eligibility**

An eligible person may obtain the following tags in addition to any tags obtained through a draw process. Heritage tags, deer and antelope landowner damage compensation tags, elk incentive tags, antlerless elk landowner tags.

A second drawing will be held for all remaining tags for deer, antelope, black bear, elk, mountain goat and subspecies of bighorn sheep. Applicants, who are eligible, may apply for remaining tags in the second drawing. Remaining tags will be available to both residents and nonresidents for those types of hunts established by the Commission, except for junior hunt tags which is a resident only hunt.

**REMAINING TAG ELIGIBILITY**

Following the second draw, any remaining tags for deer, antelope, elk, mountain goat and any subspecies of bighorn sheep will be available to eligible applicants through a first-come-first-served process to both resident and nonresidents except for junior hunt tags which is a resident only hunt.

If the application is for a remaining tag for a season that is already in progress the applicant must be at least 12 years old at the time the application is submitted.
