

**Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners
Legislative Committee
Charter**

Committee Name: Legislative Committee

Type of Committee: Permanent, meets on an as-needed basis. In person or by conference call.

Purpose:

- I. To become informed of legislative issues that may affect how the Department of Wildlife manages, protects, and restores Nevada's wildlife and its habitat, and promotes safe boating on Nevada waters.
- II. To provide legislative support, within the procedural framework allowed, and act as a liaison for the agency to promote agency and legislative goals where appropriate.
- III. To make recommendations to the Board for support of proposals which align with Commission Policies, the scientific management of wildlife, and which are in the best interest of the resource, the Department, and of the community.

Procedure: Once the Commission gives approval on key legislative issues, the Legislative Committee may speak on behalf of the Commission on those issues.

Membership: A total of three or more serving Commissioners, or designated appointees, appointed to the Committee by the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commission Chair.
