# Landowner Compensation Tag Program

CGR 477

#### Issue

- When annual counts are conducted to determine the number of tags a cooperator may qualify for, that number can exceed that total allowed in statute.
  - Was 1.5% prior to statutory change in 2017 legislative session, now 2.5% of total deer and antelope tags authorized by Commission.

### LCB Language

#### **Commission Direction - June**

- Clarify that longevity applies to specific properties and the addition of other properties is independent
- Stipulate the tags are awarded proportionately, not reduced proportionately
- Improve clarity
- LCB editorial approach

### Example

If limit is 200
50 - 1 = 50
30 - 2 = 60
10 - 3 = 30
5 - 4 = 20
4 - 5 = 20
2 - 6 = 12
2 - 7 = 14
2 - 8 = 16

Total = 222

### Example

Total = 195

80% reduction

## Example

If limit is 200 50 - 1 = 50 30 - 2 = 60 10 - 2 = 20\* 5 - 3 = 15\* 4 - 4 = 16\* 2 - 5 = 10\* 2 - 6 = 12 2 - 6 = 12\*

Total = 195

80% reduction

6 = 12Remaining 5 awarded based6 = 12\*on longevity in program
