Forum restrictions and orderly business: The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place and manner of speech.

Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks that antagonize or incite others are examples of public comment that may be reasonably limited. Minutes of the meeting will be produced in summary format.

- 5.\* **No Loss of Bonus Points for Active Duty Military Who Leave the State of Nevada – Data and Technology Services Division Administrator Chet Van Dellen – For Possible Action**  
Per the request of the Committee, the Department will submit a proposal to the Committee for distribution to the County Advisory Boards to Manage Wildlife (CABMW) allowing members of the U.S. military who lost their bonus points due to two consecutive years of non-application to submit a written request to the Department within one year of their return to their permanent duty station to have their points reinstated. See TAAHC Open Topic List Item A.1.22. The Committee may take action to submit their recommendation to the Commission.

6\* **Draft Proposed Regulations to Clean Up Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 502 Following License Simplification – Data and Technology Services Division Administrator Chet Van Dellen – For Possible Action**

The Department will present a draft proposed regulation to Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 502 to clean up overlooked amendments and include consistent language following the 2017 licensing simplification implementation. The Committee may take action to submit the Department proposed regulations to the Commission for workshop.
