Dear Mr. Thissell:

Your subguide license renewal application for 2019 has been denied for the following violations:

- NRS 502.130 Tags, permits and seals required to hunt, trap, fish or possess designated wildlife. Conviction date March 3, 2019 Bail Forfeiture in Elko Justice Court
- Conviction of Criminal Trespass in the Second Degree on September 10, 2018 in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Harney.

NAC 504.671 lists "Grounds for denial, revocation or suspension of a license. The Department may deny an application for or revoke or suspend a guide's license for any of the following..." Therefore, your 2019 subguide license renewal application will be denied for a conviction of having violated title 45 of NRS and for a conviction of having violated an equivalent provision in the law or regulations of any other state or the Federal Government NAC 504.671(6)(a).

If you would like to appeal the denial for your 2019 Subguide license, you must submit a written request for a hearing before the Board of Wildlife Commissioners no later than 30 days after you receive this notice, in accordance with NAC 501.150(1). This form can be found at:

Dear Mr. Thissell:

On March 26, 2019 you were sent a letter advising you that your subguide license renewal for 2019 had been denied per NAC 504.671.

Your appeal hearing has been scheduled to be heard at the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners meeting on June 22, 2019 at 9:00A. The meeting will be held at the El Capitan Lodge & Casino at 540 F St., Hawthorne, NV 89145.

Per NAC 501.153 "At least 14 calendar days before the date set for a hearing for an appeal, each party to the appeal must file with the Commission and serve upon all other parties to the appeal: (a) All documents that the party intends to introduce as evidence at the hearing; and (b) A written statement setting forth: (1) The name and address of the party; (2) The reason for the appeal, if the party is the appellant; (3) A brief statement supporting the position of the party; and (4) If the party intends to introduce witnesses, a list setting forth the name of each witness together with a brief summary of the proposed testimony of the witness." Subsection 2 also states "If an appellant fails to meet the requirements of subsection 1 and the appellant does not show good cause for the failure to meet those requirements, the Commission may dismiss the appeal with prejudice. An appeal that is dismissed pursuant to this subsection may not be reconsidered by the Commission. The dismissal of an appeal pursuant to this subsection is a final decision for purposed of judicial review."

Also, please be advised if you intend to be represented by an attorney pursuant to NAC 501.155 you must notify the Commission of that fact in writing at least 10 calendar days before the date set for the hearing for your appeal.
