


1. State the reason for the proposed regulation: After much discussion by outdoor enthusiasts, the Elko Co. Cab was requested to place shed hunting regulation on their agenda. Public comment was received from the individuals and the comments were referred to a shed hunting subcommittee. The subcommittee met with 44 interested parties and a set of recommendations were agreed upon and forwarded to the Elko Cab.
2. List the legal authority: Elko Co. CABMW.
3. Provide the specific language change being proposed: Amend NAC503.172. (Prohibition on taking or gathering shed antlers from or on public land located in Elko, Eureka, Lander, Lincoln, Nye or White Pine Counties at any time from January 1 to April 30, inclusive.)

Amendment 1. Season Closure amended to read (*February 1 thru March 31, with the ability of NDOW to extend season closure based on weather or herd condition*) to replace January 1 thru April 30.

Recommendation 1. That the Commission considers establishing an Ethics Course/ or informational publication concerning shed hunting/gathering, off road ATV/OHV restrictions, and prevention of wildlife harassment.

Recommendation 2. The Elko CAB also encourages NDOW to increase emphasis in the enforcement of this regulation by NDOW and county District Attorneys through increased fines and added demerits when prosecuting violators.

Recommendation 3. The State Wildlife Commission considers some type of licensing mechanism for shed hunters.
