Quota Rationale

The population estimate this year is very similar to what we have seen in the last few years. We had a better than average fall survey and one of the lowest spring surveys on record. With the extreme winter many of the deer dropped real low making it difficult to locate in the valleys. This unit saw an average fawn loss this winter which may be due to the open valleys. This unit once again is targeting the post hunt objective of 30.
