**Access:**

This unit can be accessed by highway 140 as well as Jungo Road. Bottle Creek Road is on the east side of the range with the Trout Creek Road/ Jackson Creek Road splitting up the range. The west side can be accessed off highway 140 from the Leonard Creek Road. Within the Black Rock Desert-High Rock Canyon Emigrant Trails National Conservation Area (NCA) signed into law 12/21/2000, there are several newly created Wilderness Areas. No motorized or mechanical vehicles or equipment are allowed inside these areas. Please refer to the NDOW or BLM websites for maps, fact sheets and other information. Unit 035 is affected in that the south Jackson Mountain (King Lear Peak area) and the north Jackson Mountain (Parrot Peak area) are now wilderness areas. The Jackson Creek- Trout Creek Road is still open for access. The Iron King, Bottle Creek, and Trout Creek Spur areas outside the wilderness areas are not subject to access restrictions.

**Recommended Hunting Areas:**

Most of the harvest comes from the Jackson Mountains, particularly north of the Trout Creek - Jackson Creek Road. Deer populations are somewhat more scattered south of there but does offer good hunting opportunities. Areas above Happy Creek as well as south of Iron King Mine may provide additional opportunity if hiked into. The Bloody Run Range has low deer densities and fewer opportunities but still provides some quality experiences.

**Biologist Comments:**

Seasons for chukar and most upland game species are open during the regular deer season.
