

Species: Mule Deer

Unit Group: 041,042

Access:

Units 041, 042 are located east of Highway 447 and the town of Gerlach and west of Interstate 80 and the town of Lovelock in Pershing and Humboldt Counties. See Nevada Hunt Book for specific details. Access is good to all units. Four-wheel drive vehicles are necessary.

Facilities and Services:

Hospitals and motels are in Fernley, Lovelock and Winnemucca. Restaurants, fuel and convenience stores are located in Gerlach, Fernley, Lovelock, Rye Patch Reservoir exit (I-80), Mill City/Unionville exit (I-80) and Winnemucca.

Recommended Hunting Areas:

Deer densities within these units are considered extremely low. However, mule deer inhabit almost all mountain ranges in the unit group.

Unit 041: Selenite Range, Sahwawe Mountains, Lava Beds and Seven Troughs.

Unit 042: Trinity Range, Majuba Canyon and Eugene Mountains.

Special Comments:

Hunters should expect a challenging time finding mule deer as this population is considered extremely low. It is suggested to scout and familiarize yourself with roads and animal use areas before hunting. Camping is unrestricted. Hunters can also pursue chukars. Refer to NDOW Small Game Hunting Guide for specific dates and restrictions on chukar hunting.
