**Access:**

The main access for this unit group is off US 93 (Great Basin Hwy), US 93 ALT (Lages Junction to West Wendover) and US 50 out of Ely. Private lands and mining activity limit access in Units 078 and 107 off I-80. Otherwise, there is good public access throughout much of the unit group.

**Recommended Hunting Areas:**

Antelope can be found in most valleys within the unit group and even into the upper elevations of Spruce Mountain, South Pequop Mountains and Cherry Creek Range. Steptoe Valley is a stronghold for antelope in this unit group with antelope using much of the available land between the Cherry Creek Range and US 93. Also, several big game water developments (guzzlers) can be found in the unit group. Focus on big game guzzlers in the southern portions of Units 105 and 106.

**Biologist Comments:**

Groceries, fuel, motels, and campgrounds can be found in the towns Wells, West Wendover, and Ely. If not planning to base your hunt from one of the above listed towns, hunters should plan on dispersed camping on public land. For the most part, this is a very water limited unit group. Antelope tend to avoid high concentrations of livestock and feral horses. Search for antelope in areas around water that do not have a significant amount of competition from livestock or feral horses. Glass early and late hours of the day with the sun at your back.
