Access:

Hunter access is excellent with a few exceptions in isolated areas. Traveling east on highway 50 from Fallon provides access to the entire unit group. The main route off highway 50 is highway 722.

Recommended Hunting Areas:

Pronghorn can be found in the following valleys: Edwards Creek Valley, Smith Creek Valley, Dixie Valley, Broken Hills, Gabbs Wash, Antelope Valley, Reese River Valleys and the Carson Sink.

Biologist Comments:

Most of the antelope in this area live at elevations between 5,500' and 7,500' during the hunting season. They can be found in habitats that vary from bench type topography to somewhat steep mountainous terrain. This unit group contains more mountainous habitats, broken by hills or draws, than most other antelope areas within the state. The Area 18 pronghorn herd is well dispersed throughout the unit group. Antelope are typically concentrated near available water.
