**Access:**

Access to the hunting area in Unit 205 is provided by Highway 361, branching off of Highway 95 at Luning. The Rhyolite Pass, Calvada Flat and Finger Rock Wash Roads all offer good access into the areas occupied by antelope. Many unimproved roads diverge off of these maintained roads.

**Recommended Hunting Areas:**

Pronghorn can be found on the Gabbs Valley Range, Candelaria Hills, southern end of Pilot Mountain, Sunrise Flats, Whiskey flats, Teels Marsh, Stewart Valley, Win Wan Flat, Huntoon Valley, Paint Rock, Garfield Hills, Candelaria Hills and associated with all water developments and spring locations.

**Biologist Comments:**

The Unit 205 antelope herd was re-established by transplants made in the late 1980s and early 1990s. Habitat conditions are considered marginal for pronghorn, so the herd is not large. Animals here are very mobile and broadly dispersed, so considerable roadwork during scouting forays will be necessary in order to be successful.
