

**Species:** Rocky Mountain Bighorn

**Unit Group:** 074

**Hunt Geometry ID:** 142

**Hunt ID:** [8374842]

**Access:** The majority of land within this unit is public land administered by the Bureau of Land Management with good hunter access.

**Recommended Hunting Areas:** The Ella Dee Mountain, the Badlands (Salmon Falls Creek drainage), and Black Mountain/Little Devil's Table areas presently provide habitat for the majority of the bighorn within Unit 074. Bighorn are generally associated with water sources during August and September. Sources of water within the harvest unit vary from perennial streams to small springs. Generally, hunters can develop a good idea of where to start looking for bighorn by first becoming familiar with a map that identifies various water sources and comparatively rugged topography.

**Biologist Comments:** Hunters should scout the three main concentration areas prior to the season. Patience is the key here as many of the mature rams are solitary. Look over as many animals as possible before targeting a specific animal.
