Title: **Commission General Regulation 491, LCB File No. R058-20**

Description: The Commission will consider adopting a regulation relating to amending Chapter 502.175 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). This regulation would allow the department to use any current technology as a delivery method to notify hunt applicants of their draw results.

Summary

This regulation clarifies the authority of the Department to notify hunt applicants of their draw results by any means the Department chooses while keeping 48-hours post draw requirement. This change will allow the Department the ability to use current technology as a notification delivery method.

Recommendation:

The Department is recommends adopting CGR 491, Notification of Draw Results, LCB File No. R058-20 as written.

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 501.105, 501.181, 502.160 and 502.175.

A REGULATION relating to wildlife; revising requirements for notifying applicants of the results of a drawing for tags or permits; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law requires the Board of Wildlife Commissioners to adopt regulations relating to a drawing to award certain tags or permits to hunt certain species of wildlife. (NRS 502.160, 502.175) Under existing regulations, the Department of Wildlife is required to post the results of a computerized drawing for tags or permits on an Internet website not later than 48 hours after the drawing is completed. (NAC 502.4208) This regulation removes the requirement to post the results on an Internet website and instead requires the Department to notify applicants of the results of the computerized drawing not later than 48 hours after the drawing is completed.

Section 1. NAC 502.4208 is hereby amended to read as follows:

502.4208 1. The Department shall ~~[post, on an Internet website that is operated or administered by or on behalf of the Department,]~~ *notify applicants of* the results of a computerized drawing for tags or permits not later than 48 hours after the completion of the drawing.

2. For the purpose of calculating the 48-hour period pursuant to subsection 1, each drawing shall be deemed to have been completed at 5 p.m. on the day of the drawing.
