- 8. Second Draft Fiscal Year 2021 Predation Management Plan** – The draft Fiscal Year 2021 Predation Management Plan has been presented to the Commission. Following this review, the draft plan was updated and shared with the State Predatory Animal and Rodent Committee (PARC). All comments from the PARC, County Advisory Boards to Manage Wildlife, and any other interested entity will be compiled and shared with the Wildlife Damage Management Committee (WDMC) for their consideration at this March meeting. The Commission will receive an update from the Wildlife Damage Management Committee and may provide additional direction at that time. **For Possible Action**
