1. Call to Order – Department Representative

5. *Area 11 and 12 Project Proposal – Department Representative – For Possible Action

The Subcommittee discussed the Limiting Factor Ranking Sheet and complete the Needs Assessment Worksheet. The Subcommittee will work toward identifying 3 projects to submit to the Mule Deer Enhancement Program Oversight Committee for consideration. The Subcommittee held ample discussion during the Limiting Factors Ranking process. The Subcommittee discussed each factor and then individually assigned a score to each factor. After all Limiting Factors had been ranked for both units, the average for each factor was calculated. The Subcommittee discussed and agreed on 3 project proposals for both Area 11 and 12. Area 11 project proposals were Cooper Canyon PJ Treatment, Antelope Range Riparian Fences, and Antelope Range Predator Removal. Area 12 project proposals were Steptoe Bench PJ Treatment, Johnson and Mud Spring Riparian Fences, and Bothwick and Gleason Creek Predator Removal.

Subcommittee Member Collis motioned to approve the projects.

Subcommittee Member Ahlvers seconded the motion.
