 - a. **NBWC Item 6E E.*** Draft Fiscal Year 2024 Predation Management Plan – For Possible Action The draft Fiscal Year 2024 Predation Management Plan will be presented to the Commission for review. A report from the Predatory Animal and Rodent Committee (PARC) Meeting, held on February 2nd will be shared with the Commission. All comments from the Commission, PARC, County Advisory Boards to Manage Wildlife, and any other interested publics will be compiled and shared with the Wildlife Damage Management Committee (WDMC) for their consideration at the March 2023 meeting. One new proposed Mule Deer Enhancement Program Project 47 will be considered for inclusion in the Draft Fiscal Year 2024 Predation Management Plan.
 - b. **NBWC Item 7A*** Commission Policy 23 – Predation Management – Third Reading – For Possible Action The NBWC Commission will review Commission Policy 23 and may make any necessary changes and may decide to repeal, revise, or adopt the policy.
 - c. **NBWC Item 8A** Commission General Regulation 506, Possession of Golden Eagles Under Certain Circumstances – For Possible Action The NBWC Commission will hold a second workshop to consider amending Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 503 to allow for possession of a golden eagle under certain circumstances.
 - d. **NBWC Item 16 A.*** Commission Regulation 23-13, Migratory Game Bird Seasons, Bag Limits, and Special Regulations for Waterfowl and Webless Migratory Game Birds Public Hunting Limited on Wildlife Management Areas and Designated State Lands – 2023 – 2024 Season – For Possible Action The Commission will consider recommendations for seasons, bag limits and special regulations for migratory game birds for the 2023-2024 season and adopt regulations consistent with proposed regulations framework for the 2023-2024 hunting seasons on certain migratory game birds established by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Commission will also consider rules regulating public hunting on Wildlife Management Areas and designated state lands.
 - e. **NBWC Item 16 B.*** Commission Regulation 23-04 Amendment 1, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 Big Game Seasons – For Possible Action The Commission will consider and may take action to approve the 2023-2024 and 2024- 2025 emergency depredation hunt structure and statewide quota.
