To ensure the public has notice of all matters the Committee will consider, Committee members may choose not to respond to public comments in order to avoid deliberation on topics not listed for action on the agenda.

FORUM RESTRICTIONS AND ORDERLY BUSINESS: The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unruly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of public comment that may be reasonably limited.

The Committee and staff will discuss the proposed changes from the Department, Commission and County Advisory Boards to Manage Wildlife of NAC 503 to be submitted to the Legislative Council Bureau (LCB) and heard at the next available Commission meeting.

The Committee and staff will begin discussion of remaining regulation items presented by the Committee members and CABMWs to decide direction in which to provide the Department.
