The Carson City CABMW is in support of all Seasons, Bag Limits, and Special Regulations accept the following identified below:

We would propose that as in the 2019/2020 Season, that the season start on October 17, 2020 or later and be extended to at least February 7, 2021 to afford waterfowlers the opportunity to be able to hunt migrating waterfowl during the peak of the migration. A multitude of waterfowlers within our state appreciated the opportunity afforded last season and voiced they would desire that to continue this upcoming season.

Other comments, including a dissenting viewpoint (different than the majority) or issue brought up during discussion: Of the two Carson City Sportsman that attended the meeting, and the 9 local waterfowl enthusiasts that provided public comment via email to the Chairman or Board members, each pointed out that the majority of the waterfowl that are present in this zone earlier in the season are local birds. The actual migration does not get underway in this zone typically until November/December at the earliest, with peak in mid to late January into February/March timeframe. Additionally, migrating & local flocks tend to be more healthy during the latter months of the seasons.
