A. **Approval of SFY 2021 CAB Budget Request (For Possible Action)** Pursuant to NRS 501.320, the Nevada Department of Wildlife (NDOW) is requesting all County Advisory Boards to Manage Wildlife (CABs) to submit their State Fiscal Year 2021 budgets.

B. **Commission Regulation 20-10, Migratory Game Bird Seasons, Bag Limits, and Special Regulations for Waterfowl and Webless Migratory Game Birds; Public Hunting Limited on Wildlife Management Areas and Designated State Lands – 2020-2021 Season (For Possible Action)** The CCABMW Board will review, discuss and make recommendations to the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners about seasons, bag limits, and special regulations for migratory game birds for the 2020-2021 season and adopt regulations consistent with proposed regulations framework for the 2020-2021 hunting seasons on certain migratory game birds established by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Commission Regulation will become final pending adoption of federal frameworks. The Commission will also consider rules regulating public hunting on Wildlife Management Areas and designated state lands.

C. **Review and Consideration of Possible Changes to Waterfowl Hunt Zones for 2021 - 2025 (For Possible Action)** The CCABMW Board will review, discuss and make recommendations to the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners about possible changes to waterfowl hunting zones. The Pacific Flyway entertains changes to waterfowl hunting zones every five years, and potential changes must be noticed by May 1, 2020 to receive consideration. Any changes accepted by the Pacific Flyway will not take effect until the 2021 waterfowl seasons and would remain in effect until 2025.

D. **Commission General Regulation 490, Party Bonus Points and First Come First Serve, LCB File No. 103-19 (For Possible Action)** The CCABMW Board will review, discuss and make recommendations to the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners about a regulation relating to

amending Chapter 502 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). This regulation would allow customers to purchase a bonus point for a type of hunt for a season that is not open. The regulation also addresses bonus points for sportsmen who apply as a party. Lastly, the regulation would allow a first-come-first-serve opportunity for returned tags that miss the 14-day deadline to be awarded to the alternate list.

E. Petition – Mr. John V. Zenz - Big Game Tag Drawing Changes – (For Possible Action) The CCABMW Board will review, discuss and make recommendations to the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners about a petition Mr. Zenz has submitted a petition to change the Big Game Tag Drawing to (1) give twenty-five percent of the overall tags to the max point holders; (2) reduce the number of choices to only three; and (3) allow only up to fifty percent of the tags in any unit to be issued to max point holders.

F. Wildlife Damage Management Committee Report and Fiscal Year 2021 Draft Predation Management Plan (For Possible Action) The CCABMW Board will review, discuss and make recommendations to the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners about the 2021 revised Predation Management Plan.

G. Mandatory Indocination / Seminar for Bighorn Ram Tag Holders (For Possible Action) The CCABMW Board will review, discuss and make further recommendations to the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners about mandatory indocination/ seminar for bighorn ram tag holders. The Commissioner may take action to require bighorn ram tag holders to complete an indocination class/seminar.

H. Commission General Regulation 485, Tag Transfer, Deference, and Return Program, LCB File No. R022-19 (For Possible Action) The CCABMW Board will review, discuss and make further recommendations to the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners about a regulation relating to amending Chapter 502 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). This regulation would provide direction for allowing the transfer, deference or return of tags under certain extenuating circumstances after the passage of Assembly Bill 404 of the 80th Legislative Session.

9. Public Comment -Members of the public may provide public comment (Informational) Comments will be limited to three minutes. Any item requiring Board action not on this agenda may be scheduled on a future agenda.

10. Authorize the Chairman to prepare and submit any recommendations from today's meeting to the Wildlife Commission for its consideration at its March 20th and 21st, 2020, Commission meeting in Reno, NV. (For Possible Action)

11. The next Clark County Advisory Board to Manage Wildlife meeting is scheduled for April 28, 2020 in the Clark County Government Center Pueblo Room, 500 S. Grand Central Parkway, Las Vegas. This meeting will be in support of the May 1st and 2nd, 2020, Commission meeting in Reno, Nevada.
