Commission Regulation 20-01, Amendment #1, Fishing Seasons and Regulations for January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021 (*For Possible Action*)** The CCABMW Board will review, discuss and make further recommendations to the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners about amending Commission Regulation 20-01 to remove the fishing season closure and modify the harvest limits for mountain whitefish and warm water game fish other than black bass for Topaz Lake in Douglas County; to modify the game fish harvest limit for Lake Tahoe and tributaries in Douglas, Carson City and Washoe Counties to remove the reference to mackinaw or lake trout; and to adopt a limit of three game fish for Seeman Pond in Douglas County.
