1) Commission Regulation 23-04, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 Big Game Seasons.

2) Commission Regulation 23-05, 2023 Black Bear Seasons.

In a unanimous vote (5-0) vote, the Clark CABMW supports Commission Regulation 23-05, 2023 Black Bear Seasons as presented with the following recommendation: NDOW clarify the language in the "Brief Explanation of the Proposed Regulation" to explain whether they intend it to mean that:

1) tags are transferable to another "group" (aka group of hunt areas) after one group has closed, like the current mountain lion tag system, OR

2) tags in one group become invalid once the black bear quota in that group has been reached.

The CCABMW recommends that the policy be that tags are transferable (option #1).

3) **Commission Regulation 23-06 2023-2024, Mountain Lion Season and Harvest Limits.**

In a unanimous vote (4-1) vote, the Clark CABMW supports Commission Regulation 23-06 2023-2024, Mountain Lion Season and Harvest Limits as presented.

The dissenting opinion felt that the lion hunting season should be closed while female mountain lions are rearing their young in the January to April time frame.

In a unanimous vote (5-0) vote the Clark CABMW made a motion to reject presented changes to Commission Regulation 23-08, 2023 Big Game Tag Application Eligibility and Tag Limits and to request that NDOW cease the entire first come first serve tag process until the NRS statutes are amended to allow tags to be issued to the “Lawfully chosen alternates before and first come first serve tags could be issued.

Knowing that above motion will take time if the program is not suspended, we further request that no resident tags are issued to non-residents in the first come first serve program. Resident tags should stay with residents.
