- 2a–2b. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING WHETHER THE DOUGLAS COUNTY ADVISORY BOARD SHOULD TAKE A POSITION ON:**

2a. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION. DISCUSSION ON COMMISSION REGULATION 20-11, BIG GAME QUOTAS FOR THE 2020-2021 SEASON. The Commission will establish regulations for the numbers of tags to be issued for mule deer, pronghorn antelope, elk, bighorn sheep and mountain goats for the 2020 - 2021 seasons. (*Wildlife Commission Agenda Item 6A*)

2b. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION. DISCUSSION ON COMMISSION REGULATION 20-02 AMENDMENT #1, 2020 BLACK BEAR QUOTAS. The Commission will establish regulations for the numbers of tags to be issued for black bear for the 2020 season. (*Wildlife Commission Agenda Item 6B*)
