- 1* **Commission Regulation 21-03 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 Big Game Seasons.** The Board will consider recommendations to the Commission as they consider adopting the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 hunting seasons and dates for mule deer, pronghorn antelope, elk, bighorn sheep, and mountain goat, including limits, hunting hours, special hunt eligibility, animal sex, physical characteristics, hunt boundary restrictions, and legal weapon requirements, and emergency depredation hunt structure and statewide quota. (Public Comment)

- 2* **Commission Regulation 21-04, 2021 Black Bear Seasons.** The Board will consider recommendations to the Commission as they consider adopting the 2021 hunting season dates, open managements units, hunting hours, special regulations, animal sex, legal weapon requirements, hunt boundary restrictions, and dates and times for indoctrination courses for black bear.
