The Nevada Department of Wildlife shall provide training at no cost to the teacher (s) as well as an NASP Standard archery kit valued at approximately \$3,200 to the above-named School. A Standard Archery kit shall include the following items:

- 1. 10 right-handed Genesis bows
- 2. 2 left-handed Genesis bows
- 3. 1 bow rack
- 4. 1 safety curtain
- 5. 120 arrows
- 6. 1 repair kit
- 7. 5 archery targets

agrees the following terms:

- A. The school will retain on staff, an instructor qualified to teach the National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP) archery curriculum. The instructor must have successfully completed the Basic Archery Instructor (BAI) training course.
- B. The archery unit curriculum will be taught during school/business hours for 4th thru 12th grades, and if you chose to as an after-school program or a combination thereof, respectively, on a yearly basis for a minimum of five (5) years.
- C. The archery equipment will be used by the schools (at minimum) for the purpose of in-school archery instruction. NASP basic curriculum must be taught at a minimum of 10 hours during in school curriculum per school year. The equipment may also be utilized by the afore mentioned school for after-school archery clubs, school archery leagues, 4-H archery programs, summer outdoor archery programs or other community archery programs, as needed.
- D. All BAI Certified Instructors for the school are required to complete an annual report at the end of each school year. Failure to do so will result in suspension of their BAI Certification.
- E. The school archery program instructor agrees to properly maintain and/or replace worn out or damaged archery equipment.

F. All the archery equipment listed above will be returned to the **Nevada Department of Wildlife**, if the archery program is no longer implemented at the school, or if the school fails to retain a certified instructor on staff, as outlined in paragraph A.

This agreement may be executed separately by both parties; however, is effective **ONLY AFTER** signatures are obtained by representatives of both organizations.
