General information: Cave Lake is slated for dam rehabilitation in 2023. Depending on weather, construction will begin spring 2023 and the project completed in one year. Even though fishing is not available to the public, camping and all other activities associated with Cave Lake State Park are still available. Once construction is completed, NDOW will assess water quality to determine when the appropriate time is to begin restocking fish into the lake.

Location: White Pine County, 7 miles south of Ely on highway 93 and 7 miles east on State Route 486. Use our FishNV tool (<https://fish.wildlifenv.com/>) to find waters near you, and buy your fishing license at ndowlicensing.com.

Size: At capacity, Cave Lake is 32 surface acres with an average depth of 25 feet and a maximum depth of 53 feet.

Management: Nevada Department of Wildlife manages the fishery as a put and take cold water fishery. Cave Lake sits on Cave Lake State Park, administered by Nevada Division of State Parks.

Amenities and General Info

- CXT restrooms and showering facilities available to the public.
- Campgrounds for tent camping and travel trailer available by reservation or first come first serve basis.
