**General information:** James Kinney Pond is a community Pond located just outside of the Winnemucca city limits along the Humboldt River. James Kinney in mainly a stocked trout fishery, but several warmwater fish species are also stocked (Channel Catfish, Bluegill, Yellow Perch, and Largemouth Bass).

**Location:** Humboldt County, SR 795 near the Humboldt River. Use our FishNV tool (<https://fish.wildlifenv.com/>) to find waters near you, and buy your fishing license at [ndowlicensing.com](http://ndowlicensing.com).

**Size:** One acre and a maximum depth of eight feet.

**Management:** Nevada Department of Wildlife manages the fishery as a Put and Take Cold Water Fishery and a General Warmwater Fishery.

### Amenities and General Info

### Fishing

- Year round
- During hours that park is open to the public
- No boats, float tubes, kayak or watercraft allowed.
- Limit is 3 gamefish.

### Fishing notes

- Best trout fishing typically occurs in April, May June, September, October. January ice fishing can be good. Fishing for Largemouth bass and Bluegill is best from May-September.
- Small spinners, powerbait, and worms are standard tactics that work well for trout.
- Small rubber jigs or plastics tipped with a worm is effective for Bluegill.
- Try spinner baits and soft plastics for Largemouth Bass.
