STATE OF NEVADA BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

FISHING SEASONS CR 23-15

The Board of Wildlife Commissioners, under the authority of 501.181 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, does hereby adopt the following regulation for the management of the fisheries resource:

2024/2025 FISHING SEASONS JANUARY 1, 2024 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2025

LIMITS

"Daily Limit" means the maximum number of game fish that may be lawfully taken and reduced to possession by a person in one day. The "Possession Limit" is two times the daily limit for the water in which the fish were caught. A daily/possession limit includes fish caught in Nevada which have been processed or preserved and are stored at any location. Fish that are caught and immediately released back to the water alive are not considered to be reduced to possession or part of the limit.

A person shall not reduce game fish to possession if he already has the number of that fish in possession which equals or exceeds the possession limit of the water being fished.

General limits are listed by region. Exceptions to general limits are included as "special regulations" and are listed by individual water.
